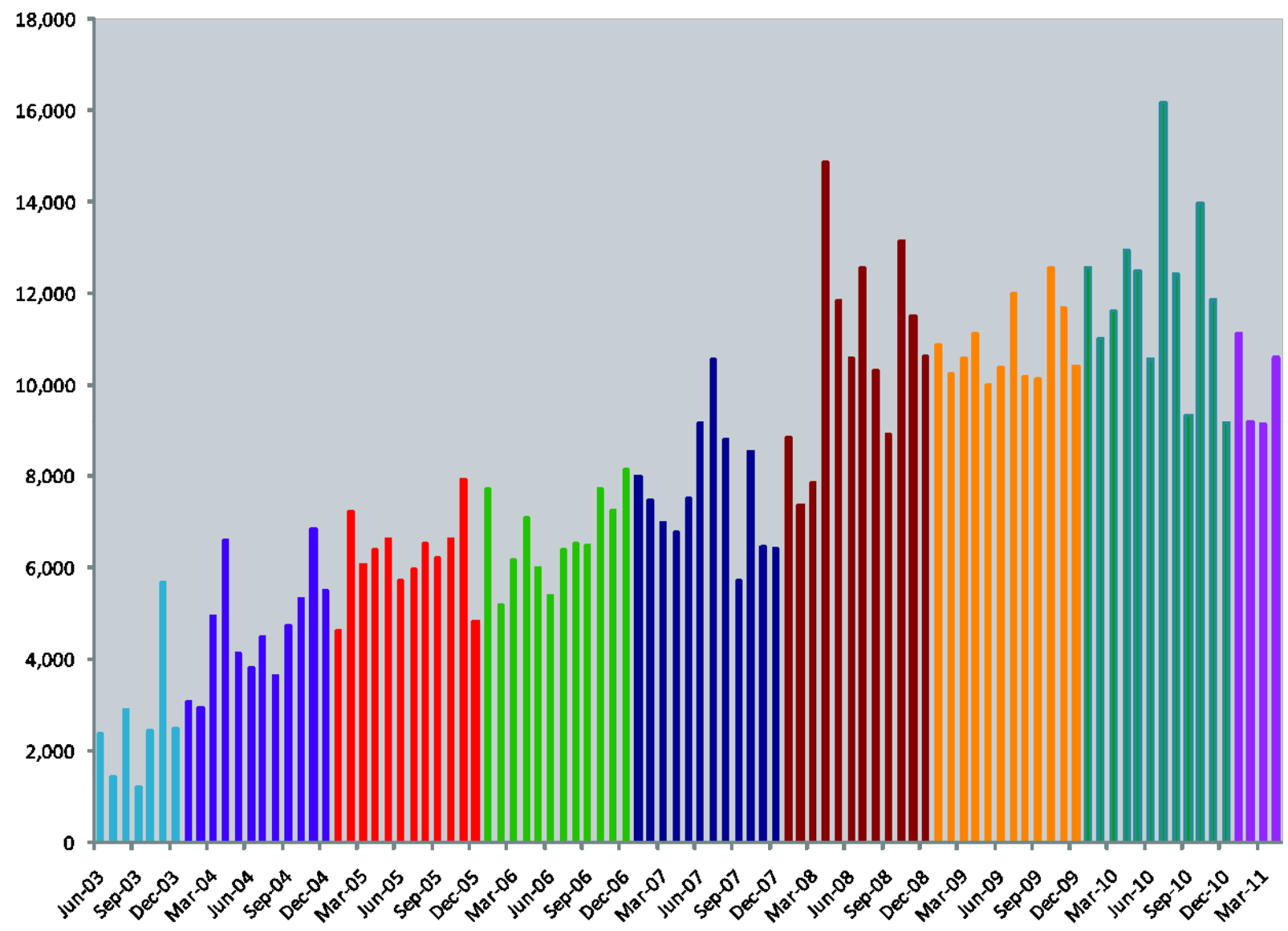

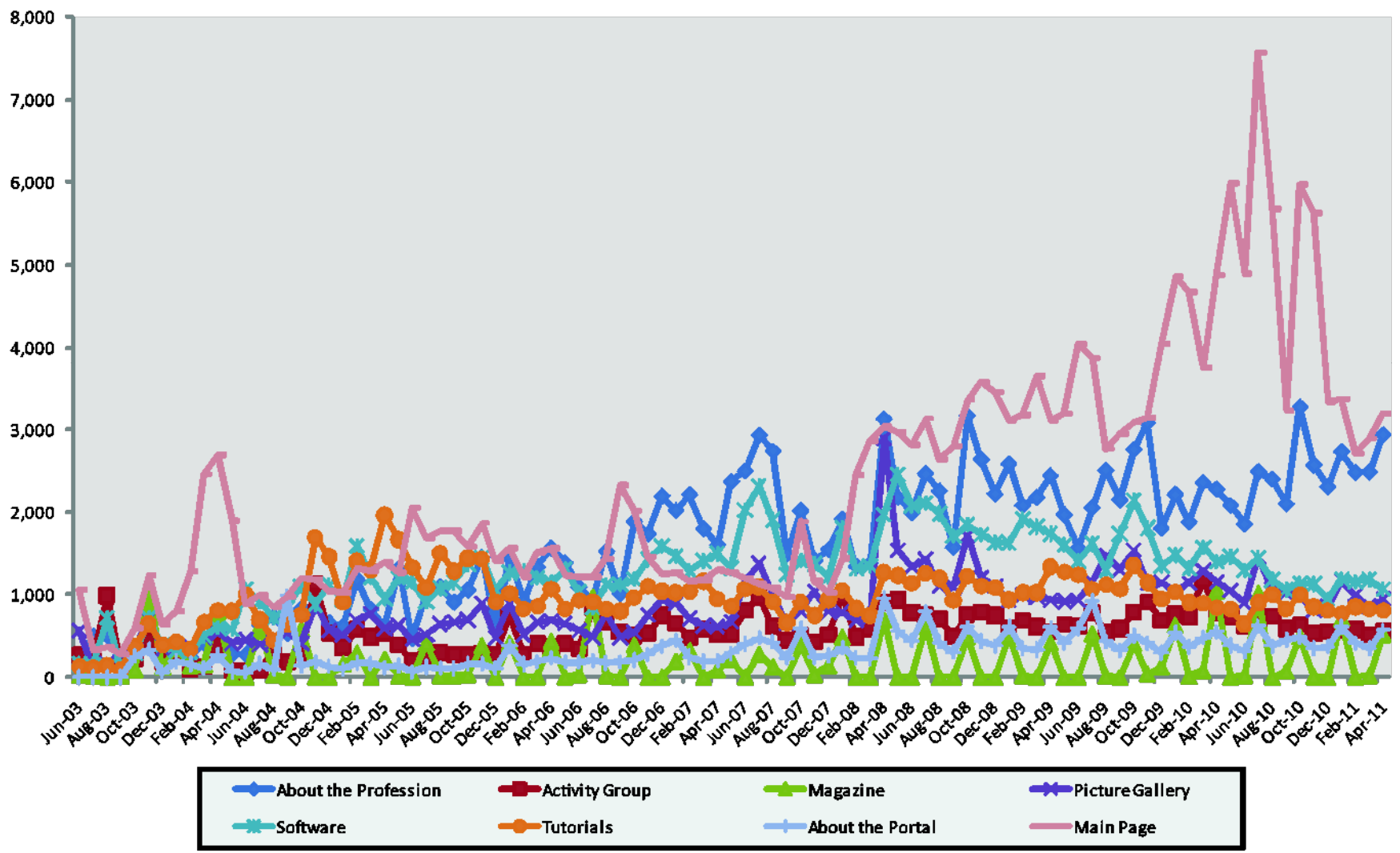

SIAM encourages submissions to DSWeb. You must use your username and password if you want to submit content to DSWeb. Submissions are reviewed by the editorial board before they are posted.

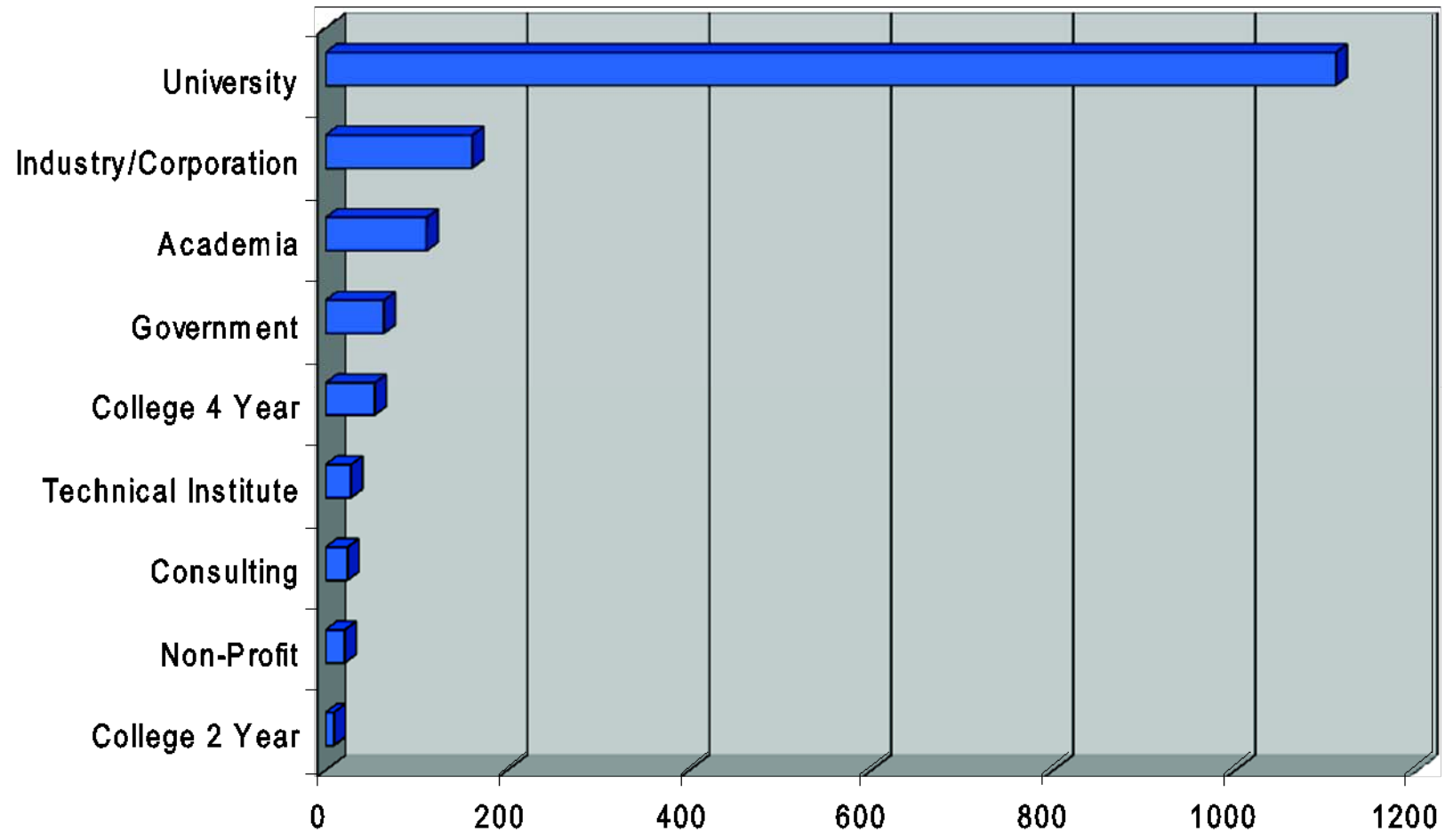
DSWeb Usage Trend by Month



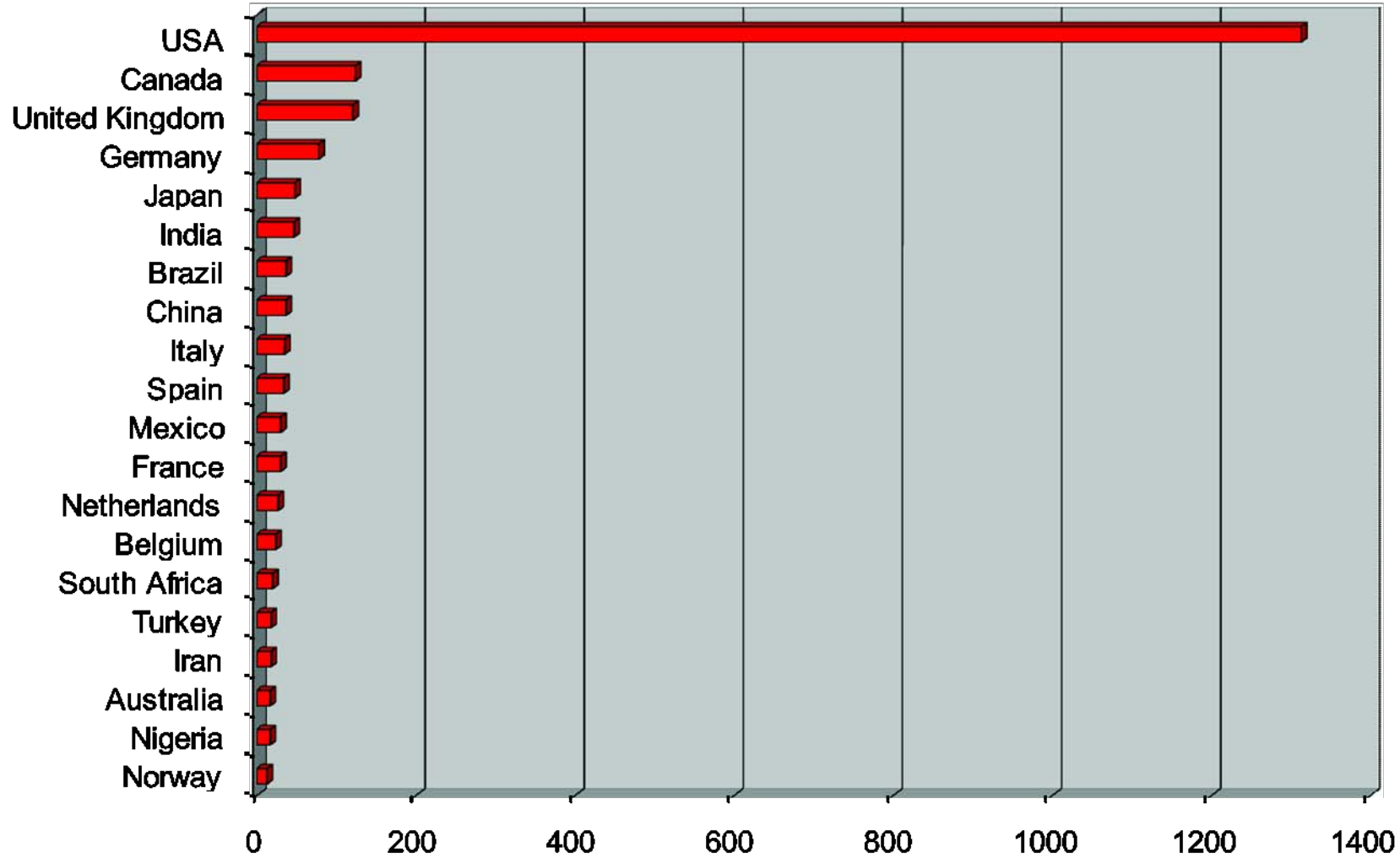
DSWeb Usage Trend by Month per Section



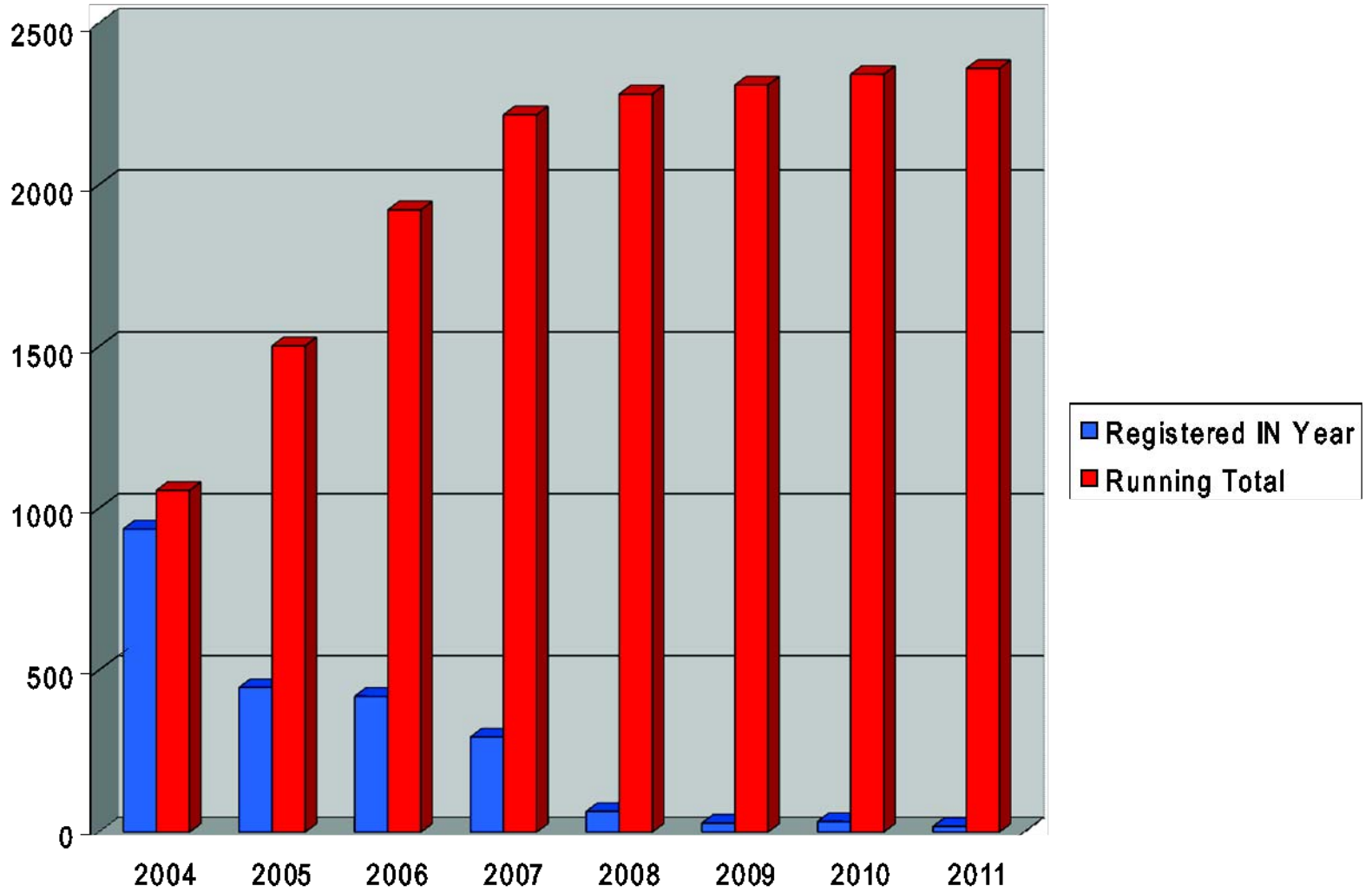
DSWeb User Affiliations

DSWeb Registered Users



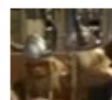

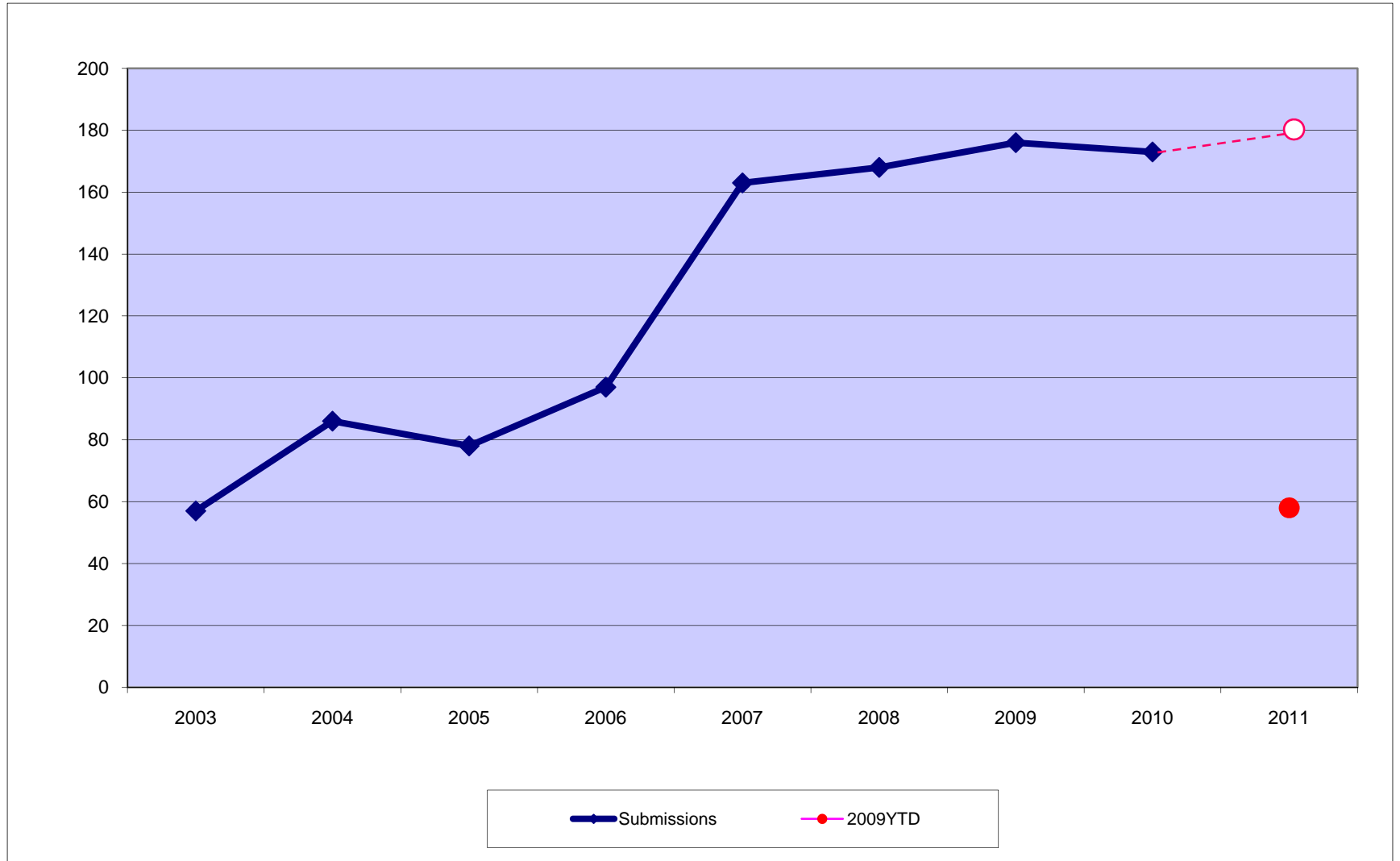

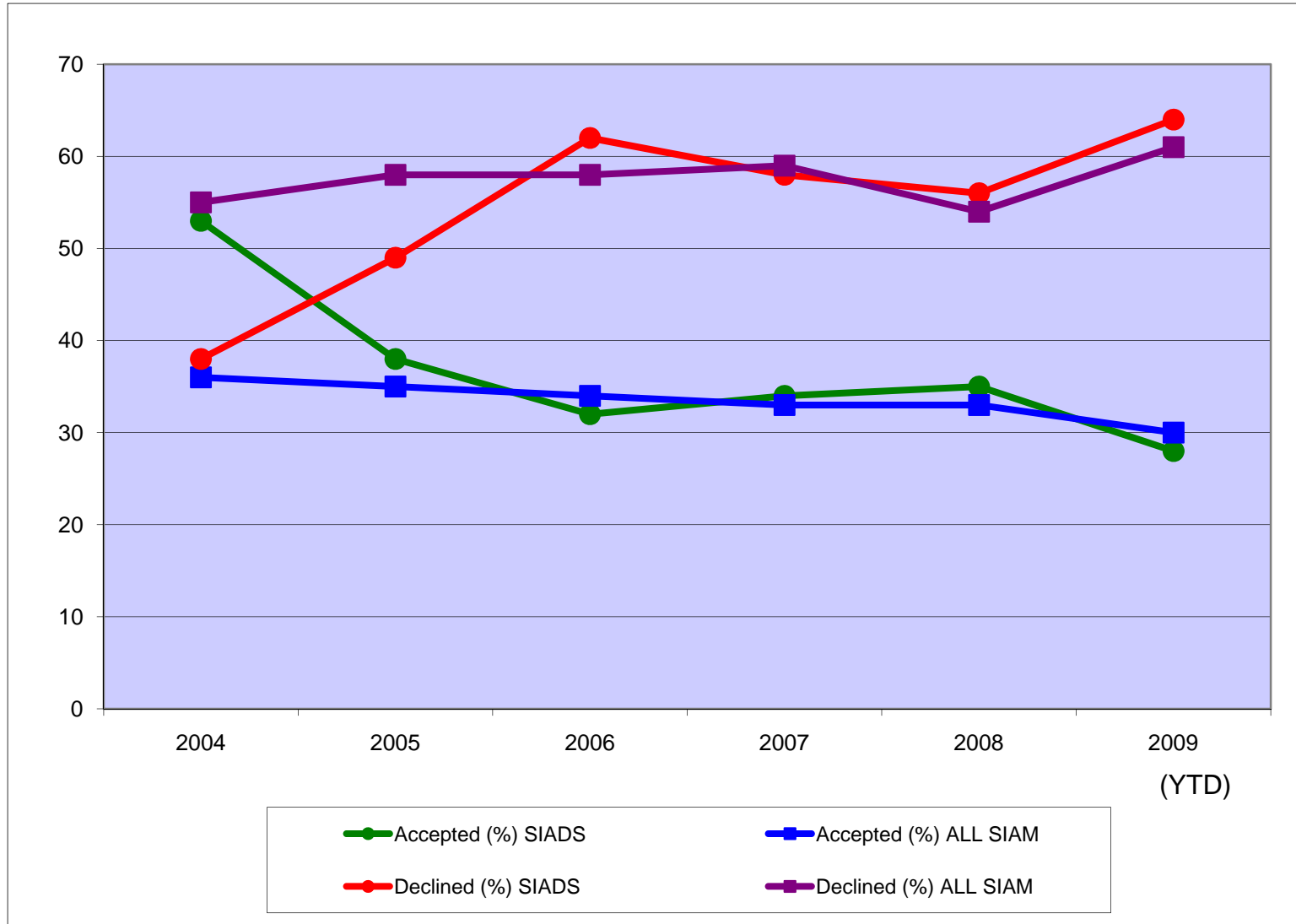

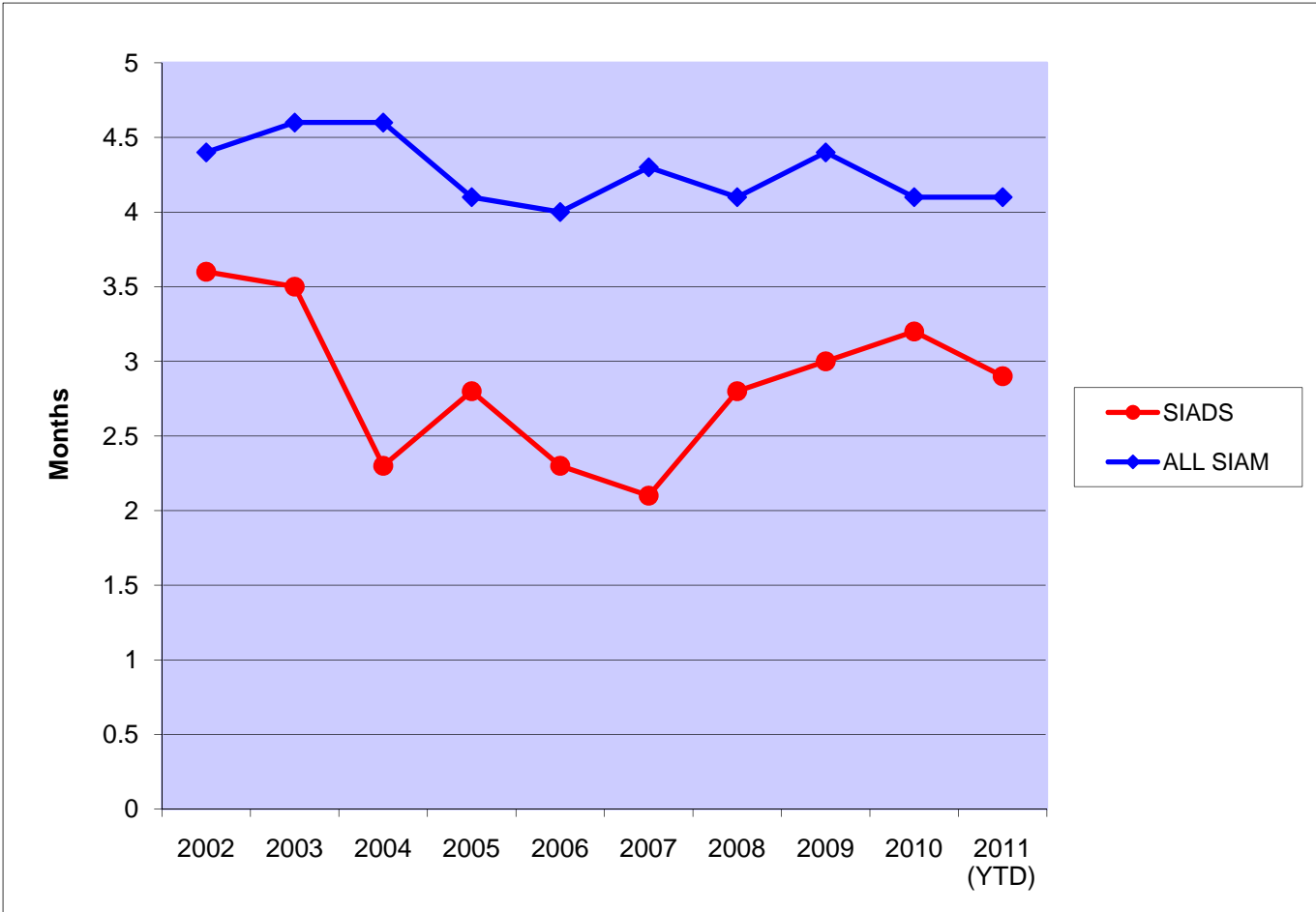

Percentages Accepted and Declined

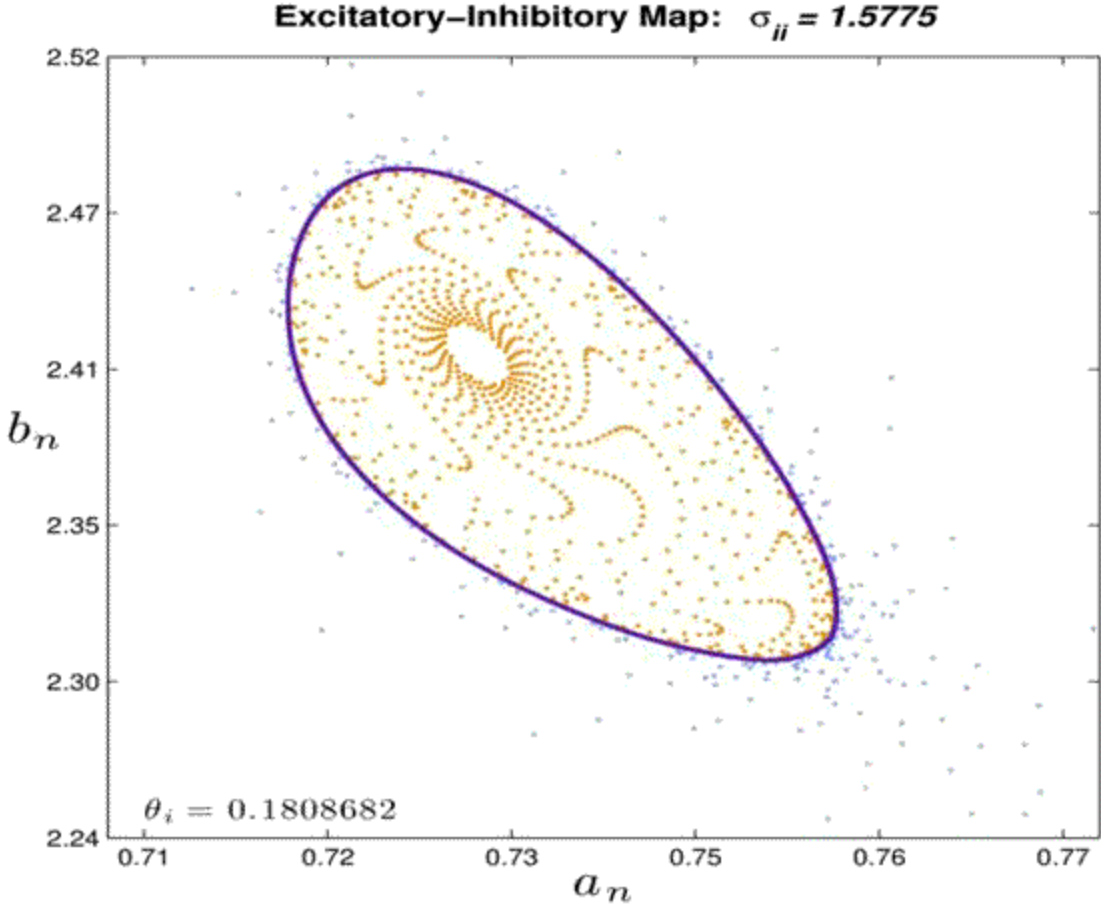
